

Overview

3M™ Flexible Prismatic Retroreflective Sheeting Series 3300i, 3M™ Flexible Prismatic Retroreflective Prestriped Sheeting Series 3334i/3336i, and 3M™ Flexible Prismatic Retroreflective Cone Sheeting 3340i may experience raised portions of sheeting. These “cell pillows” visually appear as bubbles in the sheeting. This is a temporary effect and is NOT a defect in the sheeting.

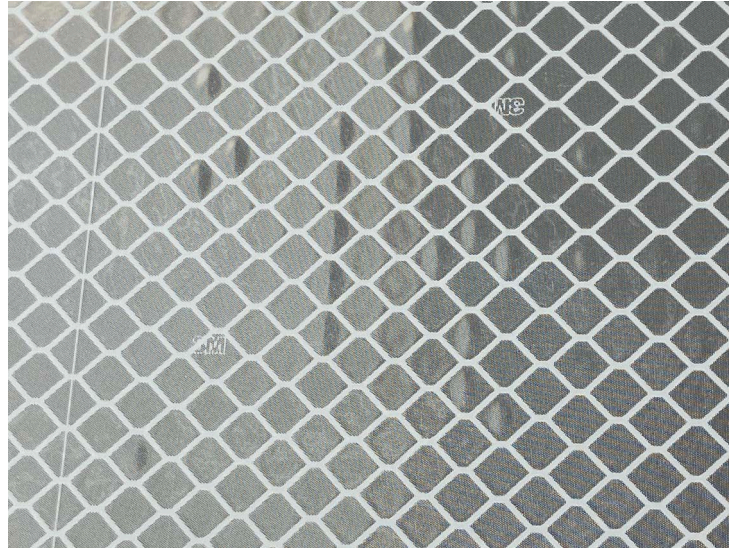


Figure 1. Cell Pillows

Cause and Occurrences

The cell pillows occur as part of the manufacturing process. On rolled material these cell pillows may be more frequent the closer the sheeting is to the core.

Effects

This is NOT a defect in the sheeting, but rather an effect that does not impact the products’ ability to meet the specifications stated in the relevant product bulletins.

Resolution

The appearance of cell pillows lessens over time after the sheeting is applied to round or curved surfaces, and on flat applications when the final traffic control device is allowed to rest. The time required for the cell pillows to become less visible is dependent on temperature and humidity conditions post-application.
