3M™ Heavy Duty Multi-Surface Cleaner Concentrate 2L is a concentrated product designed to be diluted and dispensed using only the 3M™ Twist 'n Fill™ Cleaning Chemical Management System.

Ready-to-use 3M™ Heavy Duty Multi-Surface Cleaner is formulated to remove spots, stains, and grease from most washable surfaces.

- 0.5-gallon bottle
- Four bottles per case

Each 0.5-gallon bottle yields 7.25 ready-to-use gallons (1:13 dilution ratio).

3M™ Heavy Duty Multi-Surface Cleaner Concentrate 2L

- 0.528-gallon bottle
- Six bottles per case

Each 0.528-gallon bottle yields seven ready-to-use gallons (1:13 dilution ratio).

General Use Directions

Dispense 3M™ Heavy Duty Multi-Surface Cleaner Concentrate 2A into a properly labeled container using the 3M™ Flow Control System Dispenser.

Dispense 3M™ Heavy Duty Multi-Surface Cleaner Concentrate 2L into a properly labeled container using the 3M™ Twist 'n Fill™ Cleaning Chemical Management System.

NOTE

Before using on carpet or upholstery, test for colorfastness in an inconspicuous area.

NOTE

Before using on painted surfaces, test the product in an inconspicuous area to determine if it is suitable for use.

1. Spray the ready-to-use cleaner on the mark.
2. Scrub as required using a hand pad or sponge.
3. Wipe the surface dry.
4. When used on carpet or upholstery, blot to remove spots or stains and rinse with water.
